7. New Business

- * Brad Wiggins KPSRA
 - * Would like the parents and complainers to contact KPSRA through the association. There are legitimate complaints.
 - * The channels are the teams got to their club and the club goes to NSYSA. Team to Club President, President of the club to President of NSYSA.
 - * We have young referees and they do make mistakes at times. We are working to help retrain some referees.
 - * How is invoices going? No delinquent invoices by clubs.
 - * Craig Dean memorial fund for current referees for college or trade school tuition. \$1,000 fund. Looking at next year for new referees for a fund for uniforms or flags. Something coming for next season.
- * NSYSA Treasuer wants to verify that all clubs are 501(c)3 and have a business license. If Clubs have this, NSYSA can stop paying Small Sided Referees. It is more work for the Treasurer and the VP of Comp to have to pay the referees. Originally, NSYSA was asked to do this for the clubs to alleviate work for the clubs getting a business license and setting up with the State to be able to play employees. If we continue have NSYSA pay the referees, VP of Comp requests that clubs do not adjust the pay scale during the season, after the scheduling meeting in August. President would like clubs to discuss if they would like NSYSA to continue paying referees and invoicing clubs, or do clubs want to go through the process so they can pay small sided referees them selves with the 501(c)3 status and business license.

Do clubs want to set an association fee schedule for the different age groups or vary by individual club. If clubs want to have their own pay schedule, the clubs need to have the pay schedule set by the scheduling meeting and they are locked at the scheduling meeting.

Subj: October 2019 VP of Comp Report

- 1. I still read many referee reports where coaches have not provided rosters at the field. I would like to stress, it is the priority of all Clubs, Association, and WYS to provide a safe environment for our kids.
 - a. The roster is the one secure means of doing so.
 - b. Fortunately, through the committed work of our NSYSA Website Administrator we now have rosters which represent staff members from both teams.
 - c. Sideline Conduct U07 thru U10, parents and spectators SHALL remain on the opposite side of the field away from the teams.
 - d. Some Clubs have chosen to make a minor exception to this rule.
 - i. For U05 & U06, coaches may be present on the field. From U07 and above all coaching shall be from the touchline.
 - ii. For U05 & U06, Parents may be on the side with the team. But all parents must be outside of the technical area of the team. From U07 and above, only rostered individuals may be on the touchline of the team.
- 2. I have heard comments about coaches using guest players at recreation games. I have spoken with the NSYSA Registrar and received some clarification.
 - a. Players must be registered with another team.
 - b. The player must get a player's pass to play with the second team.
 - c. Handwritten names on a roster is not acceptable.
 - d. Each player must be covered by a minimum of WYS Insurance.
- 3. I would like to congratulate all the Clubs who held clinics and supported the training of a new class of referees.
 - a. The first two weeks of referee assignments where 95% plus successful.

- 4. But we now are experiencing roughly 20% or greater games without referee coverage.
 - a. How have we welcomed these new referees into our community?
 - b. Do we allow the maturing process to transform and developed knowledgeable and experienced referee for the future?
 - c. Are we understanding of the fact that the referee is human and therefore vulnerable?
- 5. Northwest Youth Soccer Association has had two incidences of "Referee Abuse' which is administrated by the State Offices of the appropriate league.
 - a. Findings in this matter may or will be suspension. The duration is a matter of the degree of abuse.
- 6. Northwest Youth Soccer Association has had one incidence of a parent sent away from a field for disruptive and disrespectful conduct.
- 7. I have read multiple coaches reports of all kinds about 'That Other Coach.' and conduct which is unacceptable.
- 8. I have read many coaches reports that are derogative to the referee.
- 9. Each week there is several coaches reports that speak of the unacceptable language that is being used on the field by the players. And these occasions are not always happening with the older players.
- 10. WHY are we letting players, coaches, and parents be destructive of the job the referee does and the game of soccer?
- 11. We have a finite number of experienced referees.

- 12. These young referees are our tomorrow. They are the resource pool of the future.
- 13. If you have problems with a referee, notify your Club officers.
 - a. In turn, Clubs notify your Association.
 - b. In accordance with the KPSRA contract only the Association Officer may bring these kinds of issues to the Referee Association.
- 14. Recreation Cup registration is coming to an end fast. October $31^{\rm st}$ is the registration closure date and roster freeze.
 - a. We currently have 27 teams registered and approved.
