NSYSA Scheduler and Webstaff report - December 2021

Fall Season has concluded. 1,185 Fall NSYSA games were scheduled. Additionally scheduled games included:

- 52 Soccer To The Maxx
- · 38 Rec Cup
- 162 Fall NPSL
- 90 Fall RCL

Standings and Sportsmanship results were calculated and supplied to VP of Admin and VP of Comp in absence of a VP of Awards position.

#### Rec Cup is underway

#### System Situations -

Board meeting - The workflow for the monthly NSYSA meeting has changed so that we can assure everyone has:

- · pre-registered,
- · updating their agreement to the Code of Conduct, and
- make sure everyone has access to the current and complete meeting packet.

Code of Conduct agreement – The previously eSigned Code of Conduct has been incorporated into NSYSAsoccer.org User= monthly Member link, required to access the above Zoom Board meeting details. Guests or not NSYSA visitors to the Board will have traditional PDF's of the 'Code' to sign and return in order to participate.

Club Assignors - local Referee search was enhanced to aid BSC in assigning STTM games, and has been added to Directory

Started work on 2022's Schedulers Tool Kit – Lessons learned from 2021 season will include updated Field Key and New Match checks addressing Small Side referee assignments and pay, and Club's attestation that they'll be responsible for scheduling fees associated with all New Matches submitted.

All Team Staff will be deleted – Read my Op Ed below. Going forward Registrars will have to input all Coaching Staff a new each season.

Adjusted Standings to account for Forfeited games – Previously forfeiting was never an option. But this season we had a handful of games – mostly Small Sided matches – where non-COVID related forfeiture was selected over playing the game.

Making Mountains out of Mole Hills – An Op Ed - Yes 0.45% of Full Sided Sportsmanship ratings were scored a '1' without the opposing coach offering a narrative explanation, and Yes, 0.75% of our teams had an inactive member of the their coaching staff appear on the Game Day Rosters without updating their current RMA's.

Both are unfortunate statistics. But all 5 examples, out of the 932 total, does not indicate a "Large Problem" by any statistical stretch of one's proper and realistic vocabulary.

Technology can't solve 100% of our problems. We can be either forgetful, unaware, or indeed desiring to 'cheat' the system.

Instead of attempting to further enhance the systems we have, I suggest that we take a low-tech approach, reach out and contact the 5 "Problems," asking each if they really meant to deliver a silent '1' on a Sportsmanship rating, or if they even knew they were still listed as a current member of the coaching staff for XYZ Team – albeit with an expired RMA?

I'm confident that in no worse than 4 out of the 5 incidents, we'd find a sincere "Oops and Sorry" that can be quickly corrected. And in the case of that one true "Problem" our current technology successfully identified our 0.11% "True Problem(s)", and they can be dealt with accordingly.

Subj: December 2021 VP of Comp Report

- 2021 NSYSA Fall Recreation Soccer has completed. It was disrupted by covid, but not interrupted.
- We had a successful Soccer To The Maxx campaign. Thank you very much Bremerton Soccer Club for your hosting and manning. It is not without volunteers that we are able to make an event successful.
- I want to thank the Small Sided Clubs for their willingness and cooperation in allowing Kitsap Alliance Academy to be allowed to be a part of our SSGame this season. I personally believe that the experience was genuinely positive.
- 4. As much as I want to say that each game reported as a Sportsmanship rating of '1' would be associated with a report of no referee to officiate the game. I am wrong! Maybe 20% of games rated with a '1' did not have a referee. So, what is the problem?
  - a. How many coaches felt implored to rate their opponent a '1' but not say why?
  - b. Was there a problem which needed righting? Who knows, no one said.
  - Is there disrespect or foul play being allowed in the game and nobody is reporting
  - d. And all this with a referee present and no misconduct being reported.
  - e. None of what is being reported by a '1' without reason justifies the ranking or the harming the opportunity of a Sportsmanship ranking.
- Coach's Reports, what is their purpose?
  - a. How many reports had no relationship to the game and the play?
