# Washington Youth Soccer Recreational Cup District IV Portion Additional Rules

- Determination of Points to be awarded during those Preliminary Round Matches in which Points will be used to determine teams moving onto the Semi's or Finals.
  - a. Points will be awarded as follows (10 point maximum):
    - (1) six (6) points will be awarded for a win.
    - (2) three (3) points will be awarded for a tie.
    - (3) one (1) additional point will be awarded to each team for each goal scored (maximum of three (3) per team per game).
    - (4) one (1) additional point will be awarded for a shutout.
    - (5) In the event that a team forfeits, the other team will be awarded nine (9) points, the equivalent of a 2-0 shutout.
    - (6) In the event of a forfeit award, while a game is in progress, the winning team will be awarded either round robin game points earned (up to 10 points possible) or 9 points, the equivalent of a 2-0 shutout. The losing team will be awarded any goal points earned (up to a maximum of three).
    - (7) In the event of a 0-0 tie, both teams will be awarded three (3) points).
  - b. Ties in points awarded will be resolved as follows:
    - Head to head.
    - (2) Least goals allowed.
    - (3) Most goals scored (maximum 3 per game) plus (1) point for each shutout.
    - (4) Coin toss.

Some matches will need to finish with a winner and in that case should the teams be tied at end of regulation then 2 five minute Over time periods with NO golden goal and should the match still be tied then KFM to determine a winner.

For our regional portion of the tournament we will be playing 30 minute halves for U11 &12. We will be playing 35 minute halves for all other age groups for U13 and above.

### Moving Directly to Quarterfinals or Beyond

If you move on to quarterfinals or semifinals rosters with players' photos on them will be printed from the affinity (old RMA website) no player cards this year. I will be picking up your shirts from Louie Bond the Rec Cup Director on Saturday or Sunday this weekend and will arrange a time to meet you with them.

We have the following Wild Cards drawn and wanted to let you all know now as want you to prepare your teams with the individual pictures for all players, team staff etc on your rosters and upload into Affinity.
